

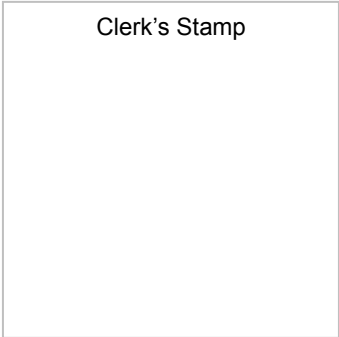

THIS ORDER:

UPON THE APPLICATION of the Plaintiff MARSHA DANDRIDGE c/o DIANA GULKA and upon noting the consent of the Defendant, THE GOOD SAMARITAN SOCIETY (A LUTHERAN SOCIAL SERVICE ORGANIZATION), and upon noting that individuals who had been identified as class members in the present claim have commenced individual actions in the Alberta Court of Kings Bench with the Court File Numbers 2203-03497, 2203-03493, 2203-03463, 2203-03432, 2203-03445, 2203-03490, 2203-03387, 2203-03383, 2203-3441, 2203-03508, 2203-03456, 2203-03491, 2203-03506, 2203-03502 (collectively, with the present claim, the “Individual Actions”), IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The present claim is discontinued as a class action, pursuant to the *Class Proceedings Act*, SA 2003, c C-16.5.
2. Upon filing of this Order, Counsel for the Plaintiff shall, within 30 days:
  - a. publish a filed copy of this Order on the website they had prepared in connection with the class action and publish a notification on same that all former class members that they may proceed by way of individual actions (the “Individual Action”);
  - b. send a copy of the filed order to the last known mailing address and/or email address for all former class members who have registered to be part of the proceeding; and
  - c. notify all former class members that they may proceed by way of individual actions, by the last known mailing address and/or email address for all former class members who have registered to be part of the proceeding;
  - d. the Plaintiff will pay for any costs related to these notifications.
3. It is hereby ordered and directed that all parties in the Individual Actions adhere to the Standard Litigation Plan attached hereto as Schedule “A.”
4. There shall be no costs of this application.
5. This Order may be signed and consented to in counterpart and via facsimile or other electronic transmission.



#### Schedule “A”

**The parties agree on the following standard case litigation plan:**

1. Pursuant to Rule 4.4(2) of the *Alberta Rules of Court*, the parties agree that the Individual Actions are standard cases and that they shall all proceed on the basis of the litigation plan set out below.

LITIGATION STEP	DATE OF COMPLETION
Statements of Defence	Within 45 days of entering this Order.
Delivery of Plaintiffs' Affidavits of Records	Within 120 days of receipt of Statement of Defence
Delivery of Defendant's Affidavits of Records	Within 120 days of receipt of Plaintiffs' Affidavit of Records
Questioning of All Parties	June 28, 2024
Delivery of Undertaking Responses	Within 60 days of Questioning
Examination on Undertakings	September 27, 2024
Delivery of further Undertaking Responses	November 15, 2024
Plaintiffs to provide all expert reports of any kind pursuant to Rule 5.35(2)(a)	December 20, 2024
Defendants to provide all expert reports of any kind, including rebuttal reports pursuant to Rule 5.35(2)(b)	April 25, 2025
Plaintiffs to provide all surrebuttal expert reports pursuant to Rule 5.35(2)(c)	June 27, 2025
Mediation or Application to waive requirement to mediate.	August 29, 2025
Date to obtain trial date	September 26, 2025

2. The parties shall provide Confirmation of a Trial Date in accordance with Rule 8.7 three months prior to Trial.
3. The parties agree to make reasonable efforts to meet the completion or target dates set out above.

4. In the event that any adjustments to the Litigation Plan may be required or warranted, the parties will make reasonable efforts to agree upon such adjustments. In the event that no such agreement can be reached, the parties will appear before the Case Management Justice for direction.
5. This Litigation Plan shall remain in effect as between the parties, subject to any amendments agreed to by the parties or as may be directed by the Case Management Justice.
